

## FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has received a subgrant application from the First United Methodist Church of Port St. Joe (Gulf County, FL) to remove and a playground and equipment due to damages from Hurricane Michael (DR-4399-FL). The Applicant will mitigate by installing a stronger, hurricane-rated flagpole. Pursuant to Executive Order 11988 and 44 CFR Part 9.12, final notice is hereby given of FEMA's intent to provide funding for the above project under the Public Assistance (PA) Program.

An initial disaster-wide Public Notice was published October 30, 2018 for Hurricane Michael. Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state, and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements, and conditions. This action complies with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements.

The Applicant will mitigate by installing a stronger, hurricane-rated flagpole.
