Proposed Work and Purpose: First United Methodist Church of Port Saint Joe proposes to repair and upgrade exterior

and interior walls, flooring, columns and beams, roofing, electrical and plumbing, HVAC, fire detection and suppression systems, and interior building contents at the 1001 Constitution Drive facility. Upgrades to the building will elevate flooring to above the 100-year flood elevation of 13 FT above mean sea level, strengthen walls and roofing, and

relocate mechanical equipment to the roof to avoid future flood losses.

Project Alternatives: FEMA has considered the no-action alternative and has found that it would not be feasible

as the house of worship is an important community facility. The no-action alternative would have adverse social and economic impacts on the local area. Alternative locations

were not considered.
