Dear Friends,



"Pinch me, I must be dreaming." This is a phrase that we say when something so great is happening that we question reality. Moments like this are made of pure grace and are not the logical result or consequence of the events of the past. I believe that Easter is such an event. Often we think that there is a cause and effect relationship between the cross and the Resurrection, much in the same way that winter yields into spring. However, this is not the case at all—only by the miracle of grace does death end in resurrection. The Resurrection of Jesus was/is a departure from reality as we know it and the entrance into a new and miraculous existence. When we walk in "abundant life" we are living in a new miraculous reality.

As we begin the REBUILD of our church, our lives, and our community, I am struck with the sincere belief that the best way to describe our recovery is in terms of resurrection. I believe that our future church, my (and your) life, and our community, will far surpass and out shine their former glory. We are not just recovering what we lost, we are not just rebuilding, we are resurrecting into a new and more glorious life. This communal resurrection is not just the cause and effect of what happens after a storm, or the result of just our planning and labor, but a miraculous gift of grace. I believe that in 10 years our church, our lives, and our community will be stronger and more vibrant than ever before, not because of the storm, but despite the storm. We will be born anew because of God's wonder-working power.

I have been meditating on the words of Psalm 126, "When the Lord restored the futures of Zion, we were like those who dreamed dreams." I believe that we are quickly approaching a time when we will be saying to the world, "Pinch me, I must be dreaming."




