Dear Friends,



The Teacher in Ecclesiastes says that there is a season for everything: A time to tear down and a time to build up. For us—both times are coming soon. The church has approved the demolition of the Sanctuary and Education wings of the church and chosen a contractor through a bidding process to do the work, which will being on September 13. There will be several weeks of asbestos and lead abatement before the demolition will take place. We plan to hold a service of some kind near the demolition date to help our community grieve the loss of such a sacred place. Since around 1950 our community has had its most sacred moments there and since hurricane Michael we have been grieving this loss.

The good news is that we are finalizing a beautiful new church plan to go in the original spot that incorporates the original architectural themes and beauty. Around the same time as demolition, our new project should go out to bid with the rebuilding of our church following in the months to come. So many people have worked so hard to get us to where we are. I am thankful for the Building Committee and their hard work and our FEMA Administrator Dr. Karl Burgher's relentless pursuit of our FEMA grant and insurance settlement. We are a blessed people. We have been through a difficult season of destruction and sickness, but seasons change. They always do. And I believe that a new season of growth and life is just around the corner.
